I think I said that you were perfectly free to do as ^{you} liked, go where you liked, think as you like, and I will claim the right to do the same. If you have really found your life-work, go to it, and if you get there, don't let us interfere with you. We can do all right for ourselves, without your help, but don't expect us to help you. Time will tell us whether you get anywhere or not. Our chief anxiety about you is, THAT YOU GET SOMEWHERE.

We will be glad to know of your arriving in England, or other port, and that you are well in Health when you get there. If you write us en-route, we will be glad, but if you can not, we will understand that you cannot.

You aim to get to Canada, here, about APRIL '57 so we will keep that date in mind, if you ship your tools, or things you want to store in the garage, we will receive them until you can dispose them, leaving us free to sell this property to get money to live on in a smaller home.

If your future demands that you go on to other parts, feel free to go where ever you are guided. Your 6 years travelling will forbid you settling down anywhere, but feel free to go where ever you are called to go.

Your Mother, feels some better to-day, was glad to hear your letter read to here. Mrs ECKER was here washed our dining room, waxed it, ironed our washing, does it, for no pay.

When you get this, you will be busy, perhaps too busy to answer it right away, getting nearer the FEBRUARY 8th your sailing date. May GOD guide you, ashore and afloat, the best of the best to you in your chosen way of life.
