

Box 3. Delhi, Ont. March 19/57 Raining.

Dear Wesley, Yours of the 13th. got^b here on the 18th. it was mailed from Guildford Surrey. The lodging house of England, is much the same as it was years ago, except mine was much cheaper, but even^{SA} it seems to me just polite robbery. From March 12th to April 5th. is 24 days you will be in Guildford, so I risk you getting this letter before you sail on the 5th. for Montreal, then to Ottawa to Evelyn's home on the 16th, then on to Alice's in Scarborough on the 17th. then the final flight home here on the 18th. All this if you get your LUGGAGE off the Empress of Britain on the day you arrive at Montreal. We hope you will get this plan thru in all its accuracy. I guess you will write to Evelyn, and Alice, this same outline so that they may have their homes ready to receive Uncle Wesley

I thought you would ship your luggage by freight to Delhi, just keeping a suitcase and the Panther for road travel, but you know what you're doing.

Your Mother, got up this morning as usual for breakfast, but a nasty spasm overtook her, I had to guide her to bed, she got better by 11am. and we had dinner together, now she is back to bed for her afternoon rest. She is very weak, seems to lose herself mentally, and at times cannot speak. She is much cheered that you are coming home, I trust she will be alive to see you on the 18th.

Alice is at work in her office job down town, I hope you can get in when you arrive on the 17th. It would be well to Phone her to let her know when to expect you, of course they are all at home at night.

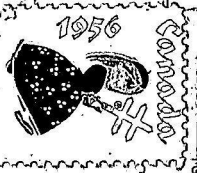
