

Wesley Leonard Social Credit Candidate

A resident of Delhi, Wesley W. Leonard has been named the Social Credit candidate in Norfolk riding in the June 10 Federal election.

He will contest the election here against Raymond E. Anderson of Townsend (Liberal) and J. Evans Knowles, North Walsingham (Conservative).

Born the son of Canadian Methodist missionaries in West China in 1920, Mr. Leonard has received his education in Delhi and district since 1925.

"As a mechanic, engineer, businessman and missionary, he has gained wide experience in the economics of politics, trade and living conditions on his working world travels," states a release by the Social Credit party.
